1. Guest rooms (twin-bed) with attached toilet and balcony : 4 nos @ 25.0-30.0 sq.m.

2. Reception and Lounge with seating capacity of 20 persons: 50.0 sq.m

3. Dining area for 20 persons :40.0 sq.m

4. Kitchen, Store and Wash : 35.0 sq.m

5. Parking space for 10 cars

6. Accommodation for caretaker and night watch man : 45.0 sq.m
