1. The Case: When you miss the favourite dishes for once at home you may feel deprived. When you are determined to get the latest electronic *gizmos* and not, you may feel furious. When you do not feel at the centre of all attention, the sensation is unsettling. Are you from the Indian subcontinent? Then ponder over these statistics:

The Indian subcontinent has nearly half the world's hungry people. Africa and the rest of Asia together have approximately 40%, and the remaining hungry people are found in Latin America and other parts of the world.

Half of all children under five years of age in South Asia and one third of those in sub-Saharan Africa are malnourished.

Nearly one in four people, 1.3 billion - a majority of humanity - live on less than \$1 per day, while the world's 358 billionaires have assets exceeding the combined annual incomes of countries with 45 percent of the world's people.

The infant mortality rate is closely linked to inadequate nutrition among pregnant women.

Throughout the 1990's more than 100 million children had died from illness and starvation. Those 100 million deaths could be prevented for the price of ten Stealth bombers, or what the world spends on its military in two days!

The Context: As you are reading this case and getting sensitized about the world you live in 200 more human beings have died of starvation. Over 4 million will die this year. However, the necessity of the hour is not to feel pity or to express sorrow, but think about comprehensive measures to diminish inequality among people.

And You: Illustrate how you would conceive to resolve this world of disorder. [15]
